HTAA affiliates can put forward the application of one male and one female teacher to be considered for selection by the Simpson Prize Advisory Committee. This Committee will then select the best two applicants to accompany the students on the trip, initially to Canberra in 2020, and overseas in April 2020. Those put forward by the HTAA affiliates will be selected on the basis of:

- having students participate in the competition
- the support of the teacher's principal
- two references which comment on the applicant's suitability for a chaperone role in the context of the trip
- an indication in no more than 300 words why he/she wants to be one of the two teachers to accompany the students in April 2020. This should include:
 - excellent interpersonal skills with students
 - appropriate level of physical fitness and health
 - demonstrated expertise in historical enquiry
 - details of how this would enhance their professional learning.

Material to support the application must be attached to this application form and forwarded to your HTAA affiliate by 8 November 2019. The decisions of the HTAA affiliates in nominating teachers and the Simpson Prize Advisory Committee in selecting the two teachers for the trip will be final.
