SIMPSON PRIZE CODE OF CONDUCT

To ensure the Study Tour is safe and enjoyable for everyone, all student participants need to agree and abide by the following Code of Conduct guidelines.

General

I will be responsible for my actions

I will read and keep all information I receive from The Simpson Prize organisers/Coordinators/Chaperones

I will be at every activity in my schedule, and will give every activity my full attention

I will arrive on time for transport, activities and tours

I will follow all instructions, requests and directions given by:

- The HTAA representatives
- The host institutions or organisation
- The teacher chaperones
- The State and Territory coordinators
- The International Simpson Prize Guides (e.g. cultural awareness, management of travel documents)

Relationships

I will be polite and respectful to other participants and chaperones

I will always behave in a courteous and responsible manner

I will encourage appropriate and inclusive relationships

I will inform a Simpson Prize leader if there is a personal or behaviour issue that needs attention.

Substances

I will not vape or smoke

I will not consume alcohol or illegal drugs.

Clothing and appearance

I will wear appropriate clothing (including Simpson Prize apparel when required) for activities and tours, and appropriate neat clothes or school uniform where necessary, for other public activities.

On public transport (including airplanes)

I will be quiet and respect the comfort of other passengers I will obey all instructions and requests from transport staff.

At the accommodation

I will keep quiet after 11pm or if others are trying to rest

I will be respectful of the accommodation policies and adhere to them

I will not enter other students' rooms without their permission

I will not leave the hotel without a discussion with one of the supervisors.

Photos and video

I will not take images when instructed not to by a guide, or asked not to by the subject. I will not publish or distribute photos or video where the subject has asked me not to.

Injury

If I am sick or injured, I will immediately inform a Simpson Prize coordinator/chaperone and follow their instructions.
