

Simpson Prize Timeline

November	Simpson Prize entries due.
December	Winners and Runners-Up are informed.
January	In mid-January forms related to the Winners and Runners-Up Canberra Study Tour must be supplied to the Simpson Prize Secretariat.
February	The Canberra Study Tour Itinerary is confirmed. Flights are booked by the Simpson Prize Secretariat. The new question for the following year's competition is launched.
March	The Canberra Study Tour occurs. Winners and Runners-Up are publicly announced.
April	The International Study Tour for Winners and Chaperones occurs.

Visit Government House – Meet the Governor-General of Australia.

Afternoon	Interstate Students and Teachers leave Canberra.
